| Small Grants – Environment (Water) | A scheme to support a range of land management interventions and provide capital support for on-farm environmental improvements to enhance the quality of Wales' natural resources. The scheme offers no loss of Basic Payment Scheme, 12 years of maintenance and premium payments, alongside an increased fencing rate of £8.32/m.
